Have you ever thought about records - fastest, tallest, biggest.....

Bucket list? One for the record, that I may recommend. Or not?

I had the opportunity to drive a very high performance racing bass boat at the highest speed I wanted; stopped at 98 mph. It was a Laser Bass Boat; basically the design is a tunnel hull-V where typical to any normal shallow bass boat. However the difference is 2 box channels running front to back that extent up to the sole/deck of the 16' boat. Now thinking, I am not really sure how it all stays together. So when moving at a high rate of speed the only parts in the water are about 3 basketball size sections at the very back of the hull and the lower unit of an EFI 350 HP modified Mercury outboard.

The torque was so great that the faster I went the more I had to turn the wheel to offset the arc direction that I was going. Oh yeah, it had a foot peddle throttle so when the boat bounced off the water you could easily let off the steam. Not to mention the kill switches, push button trims on the steering wheel and the 200 mph impact rated life jackets.

It was very COOL, although I would not do it again. One for the record book / bucket list.

Since the cost of parts for the temperature sensor, which had failed some time ago, and new wind cups were almost as much as a new sensor array I ordered a new array while the roof was being replaced. Well I reinstalled the array this weekend and it is back in operation! All the rusty bolts have been replaced with stainless and I rust

proofed and painted the stand. The new computer with UPS that we got last year seems to have solved the reliability issue so I expect that this unit will provide good information for some time.
