FROM THE BAR

From the Bar

Rene' Marques was born in New Orleans, near the Marques Brothers' Seafood Restaurant, located at Chef Menteur Pass, which was widely recognized as "one of the best seafood restaurants in New Orleans." The restaurant was owned and operated by Rene's father and two uncles. Rene's mother, being a city girl, decided that life at the Chef Menteur Pass was too remote a place to raise a family. The family moved to the Gentilly area in New Orleans when Rene' was two years old.

Although Rene played some football in high school, he found school extremely boring. He left high school before graduating and joined the National Guard Military Police. While in the National Guard, he obtained his high school diploma through Louisiana's GED program.

Rene' began dating Pauline in the eleventh grade. Pauline's family lived at Chef Menteur Pass, and her father knew Rene' well. After a recent date, Rene' waited several weeks before calling Pauline again. When Rene' did call, Pauline's father answered the



telephone. Her father asked Rene', "When was the last time you called?", then promptly told Rene', "Wait that amount of time before calling again." The telephone "click" was as close as he got to seeing Pauline for several weeks. Pauline and Rene' went their separate ways before Pauline's high school graduation. After many years, they began dating again and

decided to marry on Christmas Day, 1993. This Christmas, they will be celebrating their 30th anniversary. When asked about the most important event in his life, joining with Pauline was Rene's response.

After the National Guard, Rene' began working in construction for Westinghouse Elevator Co. Rene's first day on the job with Westinghouse required him to walk 20 feet on an I-beam with no guard rails or safety net. After Westinghouse, Rene' worked with several other companies (Otis Elevators and Dover Elevators.) and he eventually opened his own elevator company named Advanced Elevator Services, Inc., an elevator, escalator service firm with clients throughout Louisiana and Southern Mississippi.

After approximately eight years, Rene' sold Advanced Elevator Services to Kone Elevator Company. At this time, Rene' worked his way up through the ranks and achieved the position of Branch Manager with Kone. It became evident after about ten years working with Kone, that working for himself was his ultimate goal. Rene' left Kone Elevators and once again opened his own elevator company which he named EMR Services, Inc. Under Rene's management and expertise, EMR quickly became one of the largest independent service companies in Louisiana. EMR quickly grew to 23 employees, all technically competent and all State Licensed. Rene' is one of the few instructors for the Elevator/Escalator safety course that is mandated by the State Government program.

In order to achieve the mandated licensing and certification required by the State of Louisiana, Rene' started an elevator school named VTEC (Vertical Transportation Education Center). In order to administer the certification recognized by the Department of Labor, all EMR employees are required to participate in the VTEC Program.

Rene' began his life on the water paddling a skiff in the shallow water behind the Marques Brothers Restaurant. He was restricted to shallow water because rowing a skiff against the Chef Menteur Pass current was impossible, and a larger boat would be needed to find and rescue him. (There may be a story here.) Today, Rene' can be found anywhere from the Lake Pontchartrain railroad trestle to the Chef Menteur Pass flats. His fishing boat is a 22-foot Sailfish, complete with a 200-horsepower motor. He has provided 175 fillets for each of two fish fries at Tammany Yacht Club. After our most recent dinner, I questioned how a trout fillet could be so thick since trout simply don't grow that big. That prompted photographs of the huge fish that we had eaten.

Rene' has served as Tammany Yacht Club Member at Large, Rear Commodore and now Commodore-elect. We are fortunate to have Rene' and Pauline as club members. A glass of Macallen Scotch will encourage Rene' to share pictures of our recent dinner while still on the hook.






