





Seering Methodology: Low Point Scoring

Single-Handed Race -

Saturday, October 5th we had really great weather with NE to E wind at 10 to 14 kts. Our course was from near Bayou Liberty #2 to the Causeway north drawbridge, back to the Southshore Point "P" mark and thence to the finish at Bayou Liberty #2 – a distance of 28.8 miles. We had a fleet of six Nonspinnaker boats including a Maine Cat 30 catamaran skippered by Steve Earle. This is a regatta where


LPRC



It is great that we are now all familiar with the event - TYC is the host club next year, which is the 40th anniversary and we wrap up the regatta at TYC.

From Mamsie:

The 2024 edition of the Lake Pontchartrain Racing Circuit was plagued by both the weather and the Louisiana infrastructure, but we didn't let that stand in the way of having one of the best events on Lake Pontchartrain. 27 boats competed this year despite the setbacks encountered. On Thursday afternoon, after 2 boats sailed through the Highway 11 bridge in Slidell, the bridge was closed to marine traffic, leaving over a dozen boats trying to get to Tammany Yacht Club. After assurances that the bridge would be repaired in the morning we were planning for Friday's races to start on time. Tammany YC did a great job hosting the Skippers' meeting with plenty of libations and an incredible taco bar. However, as the fleet left New Orleans and Mandeville on Friday morning to compete on the west side of the bridge, we got the same message - Closed to marine traffic. The tough decision to cancel Friday's races was made, only to be followed a while later by a fully functioning bridge. C'est la vie! Saturday's distance race from Tammany YC to SYC was changed into a steeplechase type race on the south shore. The racers headed out in nice breeze but as the start time approached, the fleet was again stymied by a lack of breeze under 4 knots. After a 2-hour postponement we were able to get in a single race – a reach from A to J and back. Not the race we were looking for but at least it got everyone sailing and back to the post-race party at SYC. Trophies were awarded and lots of goodies were handed out to raffle winners. Sunday's two races suffered the same fate as the Saturday race, but this time there was no bump in the breeze after 2 hours and the difficult decision was made to abandon racing for the day. Saturday's lone race determined the regatta winners. A fun time was had by all who attended the final award ceremony at New Orleans YC, as yummy food was dished up, more goodies were given away and the perpetual trophies were awarded. Many thanks to all of the Committee members from the four Lake Pontchartrain clubs; Southern, New Orleans, Tammany, and Pontchartrain, and Corinthian Sailing Association, who make this event possible, as well as our many sponsors. Next year will be the 40th Anniversary of this event and we already have sponsors signing up. Stand by for a fabulous event in 2025.





Brillant Winter sunsets are the gifts of the season, and they can be enjoyed right from our very own TYC deck.








Tammany Yacht Club will partner with One Way Love for Christmas this year in an effort to help provide a special Christmas for children in our community.

The idea of starting a Yacht Club began at Mayer's Old Europe Restaurant on Pontchartrain Blvd. Several couples would meet at the restaurant, and a few of the wives would also join the group while they waited for their husbands to drive to the Northshore from work in New Orleans. Guy and Pat Geller were included in this group.

Guy mentioned several times that a Yacht Club in Slidell would be great. The idea became more and more interesting, and eventually Guy scheduled a meeting to discuss plans to form a club on the Northshore.

After months of discussion, Guy had about thirty people ready to each contribute \$300.00 to get the project started. The new Tammany Yacht club was formed in 1980. Guy served as TYC's first Commodore, and he continued to serve two terms in the early stages of the club.

Many members did not know anything about forming a yacht club, but Guy patiently educated all of them, including me. Guy was very active in racing and helped the newly formed club become active in LPRC. Guy convinced his wife, Pat, to organize "The First Mates" for all the women in the club. Guy was the first member of the club to be elected a "Lifetime Member."

After moving to Mississippi, Guy kept in close contact with several members of the club, and he and Pat visited the club on many occasions. We will never forget Guy 's friendship and his dedication to Tammany Yacht Club. He will forever be remembered. God bless him






