

I am grateful for your continued support in all areas of our TYC endeavors.



Patty's mother, in 2016, suffered a severe stroke that left her unable to care for herself. Patty found a daytime caregiver that allowed her to continue working during the day and then caring for her mother in the evenings until her mother passed away in 2017. After taking care of all the family business, she decided to move. Not knowing where she wanted to move, she found herself in Slidell near her childhood friends, Jeff and Patty Ward. She moved to Slidell in 2019 and purchased a house in 2020, where she resides today.

Patty was introduced to Tammany Yacht Club by her friends, Jeff and Patty Ward. She was impressed by the friendly atmosphere of the club and joined in 2019. She was then approached in 2021 by Tom Smith, who was on the Nominating Committee, asking her if she would be interested in being the TYC Secretary for the 2022 TYC Board.

She accepted the position as secretary for the 2022 TYC Board, which she still holds today in 2024.
