





What a start to 2025! As I write (Feb 1, 2025), I am calling the season/temps early springish, last week was full on blizzard and next week will be late springish..... The conditions are favorable for both sailing and fishing and the evening skies have been sublime with opportunities to site multiple stars and the moon. Today I attended a US Sailing Race Management Seminar at PontYC and it was great. I've done the seminar a couple of times over the last few years decades and this time I will proceed with getting certified as a Club Race Officer. Several things were learned, and I will get some details re changes in racing rules and RC related items out in a separate missive. For better or for worse, we will develop formal SI's (Sailing Instructions) for WedNite sailing and formalize to GYA standards the SI's for Two Against the Lake and Single-Handed Regattas.

Earlier this week I was in a GYA Offshore Council meeting and we voted to allow two clubs to combine to form a team (neither club can have placed in the top three positions the previous year) and there will be no more Vipers, VX or other dinghy-like boats allowed. These are two good moves to get more boats out and to bring the boats competing back into line with the original concept and spirit of the GYA "Offshore" Challlenge Cup.

Juniors Sail Camp

We will get online registration updated and activated ASAP. Once done we will announce to the club so members can get their families and friends registered and open it to the public soon thereafter. The dates for 2025: Session 1: June 2 – 13; Session 2: June 16 – 27; Session 3: July 7 – 18. You can contact me to hold a spot. I am seeking a/few co-chairs for the Junior Sail Camp committee. Otherwise, I will be contacting the usual suspects for work parties on the dock and boats. We are getting much closer to the approval of the TYC Pontchartrain Foundation 501c3 non-profit corporation.

Sailing events on the horizon: We commence WedNites on the first Wednesday after DST kicks in. In the spring we have two series of six races each. The first series is all Non-spinnaker, and the second series can have both Spinn and Non-Spinn classes as the fleet desires. There have been some scalawags sailing SE of I-10 for some time now and despite allegations of ill repute and reports of thar be dragons, they have pressed a case for racing there.... We will explore this with an open mind and a robust depth sounder.

Please recall what you volunteered for in 2024 as in 2025, TYC is the host club, and we will have the regatta ending here. The fleet will sail over to TYC on Saturday for the "big" party and trophies, race at TYC on Sunday and return for another party and final trophy presentation. 
