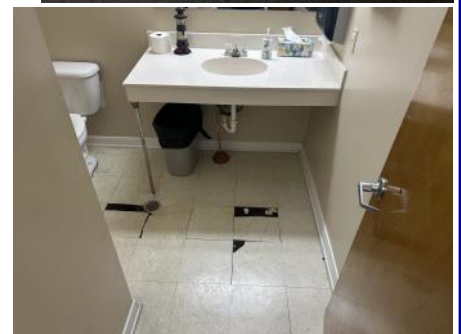

NOTICE OF PROPOSED CHANGE TO TYC BY-LAWS



In accordance with Article XIV (AMENDMENTS) of the Tammany Yacht Club By-Laws, the TYC Board of Directors is recommending the following changes be incorporated in the TYC By-Laws. The proposed changes are notated in *red italics*.

ARTICLE XI FINANCE

The Finance Committee, in conjunction with the Treasurer, shall review and prepare a written report of the financial standing of the Club to be presented at each Annual and Semi-Annual meetings of the General Membership. *"The Treasurer and Finance Committee shall establish financial controls appropriate to the needs of TYC operations. Said controls shall be presented to the TYC board for ratification and when revisions are made."*

All funds are to be deposited in a bank designated by the Board of Directors and all funds, where possible, are to be disbursed by check. All checks are to be signed by the Treasurer and countersigned by one other officer. The board may appoint a member of the finance committee to sign checks under special circumstances for the tenure of the board.

All expenditures over five hundred dollars (\$500.00) shall be approved by the Board of Directors. All capital expenditures over three thousand five hundred dollars (\$3,500.00) must be approved by a majority vote at a General Membership meeting. All expenditure of general funds up to two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00) must be pre-approved by the Commodore. Expenditures must be supported by detailed receipts which shall be given to the Commodore for submission to the Treasurer or to designated board members for submission to the Treasurer. *"Any and all transfers of funds from Capital, investment, or savings accounts into the General Funds are to be reviewed and approved by the TYC Board of Directors before such transfers are made."*

These changes will require approval by a 2/3 vote at the next General Membership meeting to be held on Friday, October 17, 2025 at the Tammany Yacht Club. The TYC Board of Directors strongly encourages all members to attend.
