Dear TYC members:

I am happy to report that our club continues to flourish and prosper and grow. New membership applications continue to roll in and I could not be happier.

Improvements continue: The thermal curtains were hung and are making an impact by maintaining temperatures in the rear dining area. The savings in the long run will offset the upfront costs. We were able to use the rods that were already in place. More savings will be realized by switching to the reuseable high flow air filter - saving us up to \$300 years annually on disposable filters. Additional energy savings will be realized by installing an air curtain system at the double doors to the patio. That system forces downward air to keep cold air in and hot air out when the doors are being used to go in and out.

August was a special month for our club - we turned 45 this year!!! What a great success story. We celebrated Calypso-style with a roasted pig, Caribbean-inspired food, festive décor, a game of limbo and a marriage game, and a fantastic DJ. A great time was had by all.


TYC Pontchartrain Foundation

Did you know? Per the TYC Bylaws, there are 10 differing membership classifications defined therein. Charter, Honorary Life, Honorary, Active, Youth, Junior, Student, Nonresident, Military, and Temporary. The qualifications of each membership classification are defined in the Bylaws. Some have questioned what differs between "Honorary Life" and "Honorary" classifications.

Per Article V...

A) QUALIFICATIONS AND RESTRICTIONS: Charter, Active, and Honorary Life members only shall be allowed to vote, hold office, etc. Membership is open to individuals of any race, color, religion, sex, disability, or national origin subject to all provisions contained in ARTICLE VI...

C) DEFINITIONS

HONORARY LIFE members may be elected by secret ballot or by a show of hands at any General Membership meeting. A two-thirds (2/3) vote of those present is required for election. Such members shall be considered Active members without paying dues. Only active or past members shall be considered for this class of membership.

HONORARY members may be admitted to membership by the Board of Directors for a period of one (1) year and may be renewed each year thereafter. Such members need not pay dues, cannot vote nor hold office unless also listed under a membership which is eligible to vote.

I encourage all members to review the TYC Bylaws and the club Code of Conduct - both are posted at the club. As always..."bring a friend, bring a neighbor, bring a business associate", sell "who we are" and we will continue to grow!
